



Author Information Pack

Submission

To expedite the refereeing process, it is strongly recommended that authors submit their paper as a PDF file electronically, through the online Manuscript Submission System.

There is no page limit. Only online submissions are accepted. The submitting author takes responsibility for the paper during submission and peer review.

LaTeX or AMSTeX are the only two formats that are strongly recommended to authors for preparing their manuscripts.

Terms of Submission

Submission of a manuscript is a representation that the work has not been previously published, has not been copyrighted, is not being submitted for publication elsewhere, and that its submission has been approved by all of the authors and by the institution where the work was carried out; furthermore, that any person cited as a source of personal communications has approved such citation, and that the authors have agreed that the copyright in the article shall be assigned exclusively to the Publisher upon acceptance of the article.

Title and Authorship Information

The following information should be included:

- Paper title
- Full author names
- Full institutional mailing addresses
- Email addresses

Abstract

Each paper requires an abstract not exceeding 200 words summarizing the techniques, methods and main conclusions.

AMS Subject Classifications and Keywords

AMS subject classifications and keywords must accompany all articles, placed immediately after the abstract.

Acknowledgments

All acknowledgments (if any) should be included at the very end of the paper before the references and may include supporting grants, presentations, and so forth.

References

Authors are responsible for ensuring that the information in each reference is complete and accurate. All references must be numbered consecutively and citations of references in text should be identified using numbers in square brackets. All references should be cited within the text; otherwise, these references will be automatically removed.

Figures

Upon acceptance of an article, each figure should be supplied in a separate electronic file in either EPS or PDF or JPEG format. All figures should be cited in the paper in consecutive order.

Copyright

It is assumed that the submitted manuscript has not been published and will not be simultaneously submitted or published elsewhere. By submitting a manuscript, the authors agree that the copyright for their articles is transferred to the publisher, if and when, the paper is accepted for publication. The publisher cannot take the responsibility of any loss of manuscript. Therefore, authors are requested to maintain a copy at their end.

Proofs

One set of galley proofs of a paper will be sent to the author submitting the paper, unless requested otherwise, without the original manuscript, for corrections after the paper is accepted for publication on the basis of the recommendation of referees. Corrections should be restricted to typesetting errors; any other corrections may be charged to the authors. Authors are advised to check their proofs very carefully before return. Corrected proofs are to be returned to the publishers.

Reprints

Five reprints of a paper are provided to the authors ex-gratis. Additional sets of reprints may be ordered at the time of proof correction.
